

Injuries caused by violent crime

This claim demonstrates the Personal Injury team's persistence to get the right award for the client.

We acted for the claimant who was viciously attacked by masked raiders whilst working at his father's pet shop.

Mr G was beaten severely round the head with a baseball bat and sustained a brain injury.

We assisted Mr G in applying to the Criminal Injuries Compensation Authority (CICA) for compensation under the scheme which is a fixed tariff system.

Medical evidence was gathered together with details of his losses and expenses. The original award by the CICA did not reflect the serious nature of Mr G's injuries and therefore we assisted him in appealing the award. After considering the appeal the CICA significantly increased Mr G's award.

After considering the appeal the Criminal Injuries Compensation Authority significantly increased Mr G's award.
